Do you travel U.S. 97 between Redmond and Bend?

Maybe you live or work along the highway, or commute from one city to another.

ODOT wants your input on how to make U.S. 97 safer for travelers.

About the project

ODOT has launched a project that addresses safety on a nine-mile corridor on U.S. 97 between the cities of Redmond and Bend. The project will identify and prioritize safety improvements for the corridor. The design of the selected improvements is expected to be completed by the end of 2019, with construction anticipated to begin in 2020.

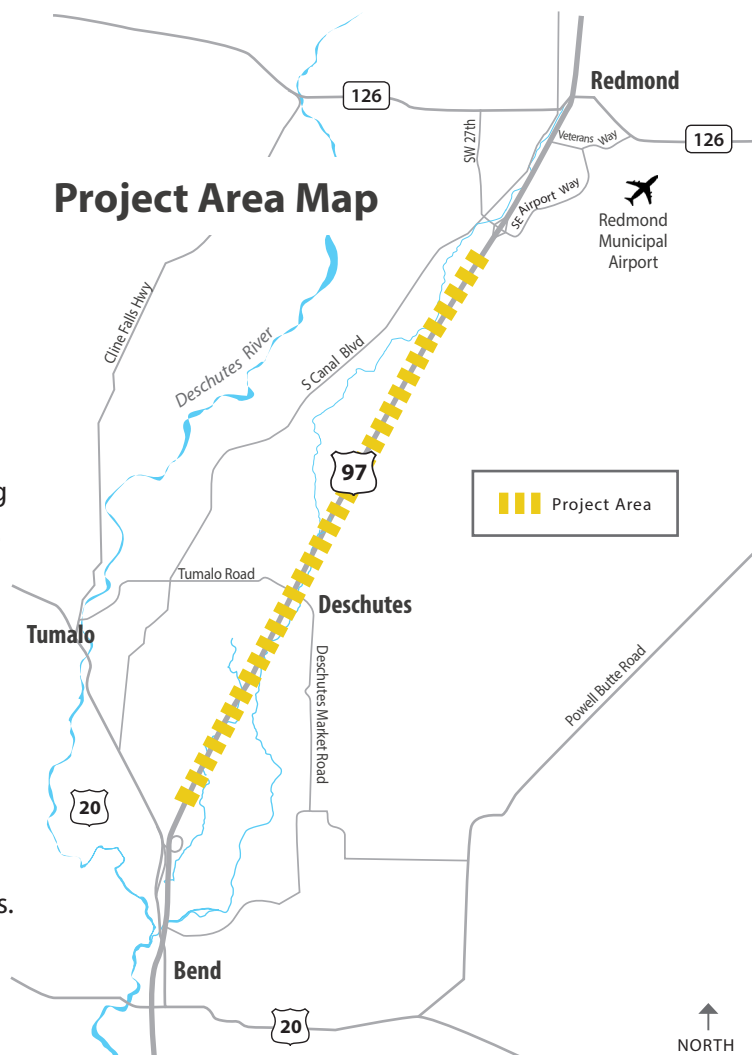
Why we need your input

This stretch of U.S. 97 has many driveways and intersections, and up to 30,000 vehicles a day traveling at high speeds. Finding enough room to safely enter and exit the highway can feel like a challenge. Data from five years showed more than 100 crashes — many of them turning movement, rear-end and head-on crashes. Almost 10 percent of the crashes resulted in serious injury or death.

ODOT plans to add road improvements starting in 2020, so the time to decide is now: What would bring the biggest safety boosts at the most locations? Lighting, entrance and exit lanes, medians? As someone who knows the road, let us know what your experiences are as we prioritize the highway improvements.
